**A38 Chudleigh to Harcombe, A38 Belvedere to Splatford and A38 Drumbridges on-slip eastbound resurfacing**

Highways England plans, builds, operates and maintains England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know we will shortly be carrying out roadworks near to you. A map detailing the location is included within this letter.

**The works**

As part of our programme of maintenance we will be resurfacing two sections of the A38 eastbound carriageway - Chudleigh to Harcombe and Belvedere to Splatford. We will also take the opportunity to resurface Drumbridges eastbound on-slip, including an element of lane one of the main carriageway whilst these closures are in place. To minimise the number of closures required, we will be working at two sites simultaneously. We will also take the opportunity to carry out cyclical maintenance within these overnight closures. We'll be working overnight when there are fewer vehicles on the road and we'll keep the carriageway open during the day as usual. Please accept our apologies in advance for any disruption this may cause.

**Dates**

**Start:** evening of 28 May 2019

**End:** morning of 13 June 2019

**Hours of work:** overnight 8pm to 6am only

**Traffic management and diversion routes**

Motorists will be diverted off the A38 at Drumbridges roundabout (Heathfield) to follow the A382 to Newton Abbot and the B3195 to Kingsteignton, where traffic will join the A380 and then merge with the A38 at Splatford (Kenn). Locally signed diversions will be in place for motorists wishing to join the A38 at Chudleigh, Harcombe and Belvedere.

We always aim to work to the programme, however **unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions may mean changes to it**. We will notify you of any major changes within the programme via advance roadside warning signs, but please also
