A38 Harcombe Cross to Haldon drainage repair and upgrade

Highways England plans, builds, operates and maintains England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know we will shortly be carrying out roadworks near to you. A map detailing the location is included within this letter.

What we're doing

We'll shortly be carrying out drainage upgrade and repair works, as well as some resurfacing. This work is part of Highways England's continuing investment in the strategic road network in the Devon area.

Why and what are the benefits?

The existing drainage has deteriorated with age. We will repair and upgrade drainage in the area to ensure it is better able to cope with severe weather events.

When will this work take place?

Start: evening of 15 August 2019

End: morning of 7 October 2019

Hours of work: overnight Monday to Friday, 8pm to 6am

To minimise disruption, we'll work overnight when there are fewer vehicles on the road. During the day we will keep the carriageway open as usual.

Please note that the precise dates and times of the works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Where possible, we'll keep you updated of significant changes via roadside warning signs.

What does this mean for you?

For road users:

15 August to 18 September 2019 - westbound overnight closure in place 8pm to 6am between Haldon racecourse and Chudleigh petrol station. A fully signed diversion will be in place via the local road network. For safety reasons a 50mph will be in place during the day.

19 September to 7 October 2019 – eastbound overnight closure in place 8pm to 6am between Harcombe Cross and Haldon petrol station. A fully signed diversion will

be in place via the local road network. For safety reasons a 50mph will be in place during the day.

Residents and businesses:

Please accept our apologies in advance for any inconvenience or disruption you may experience during this work. We'll make every effort to minimise the impact of our works. Access to properties and businesses will be maintained via local roads.
