We welcome all expressions of interest and are particularly looking for people who would like to use their skills and experience in the following areas:

- Applying online for grants from local and national organisations
- Dealing with day to day maintenance issues (e.g. carpentry, small plumbing jobs, decorating)
- Designing and distributing digital and print promotional material for the Youth Centre and KYC Youth Club

This position does not involve supervision of young people; if you are interested in helping in our youth club on a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday evening please contact us about becoming a KYC volunteer.

To be selected as a trustee you must be at least 16 years of age, have no history of insolvency and you must not be barred from serving as a trustee by the Charity Commission. Selection will be by interview. As a trustee we will provide you with all the training you need.
